

Fifth VeSte Party 2001-2002

The upward line in the development of VeSte continues this year. VeSte gets five seats in the elections and is for the first time the biggest party, together with the PSF. This meant a person more in the party, so more problems and attention fields could get our attention.

Also, the filling up of the party was a renewal: next to a SSR-member (Eveline Stilma), a KSV-member (Dave Lammers) and two Ceres-members (Sylvia Tebbenhoff and Joris Sprakel), now for the first time a non-union member had a seat: Marieke Desmense. For VeSte is for all active students.

After one year of internal reflection and positioning and principles, now it was time to use this basis for the introduction of the pragmatic alternative into the turbulent violence of the university politics.

Extension of followers

Since the foundation of VeSte in 1997 out of the student unions, VeSte has always thought of extending the group of followers. The last party has made a begin with joining an non student union member to this party. This year the party has kept on this course by increasing the contacts with study associations, Argo, going to meetings and the installment of a permanent group of followers.

Subjects

Several subjects have passed the desks this year, like the housing plan of the university, implementation of the reorganization plan (and its problems), the new arrangement for financial compensation, the mismatch in the financial planning and control cycle and, of course, the implementation of the new Bachelor Master system.

Also, the party has improved the contact between student groups en the municipality by proposing a structural counsel and organizing a debate for the municipal elections.
